



Hurricane Plan

During Hurricane Warnings or Watches issued in the area of the vessel's mooring within Dade, Broward and Palm Beach Counties MPI will adhere to the following Hurricane Preparation process.

- 1 - Upon owner's request, Vessel is removed from moorings and moved to a location which is considered "safe harbor". This may include inland locations and/or dry docking.
- 2 - Vessel's canvas and cushions are removed and stowed.
- 3 - Vessel's antennas and like items are secured.
- 4 - Vessel's lines and fenders are secured and placed where necessary. Lines are fastened to nearby pilings or trees in addition to docks for best possible hurricane protection. In some cases, extra lines are purchased and billed to owner.
- 5 - Anchors are set where appropriate.
- 6 - Vessels are checked regularly during foul weather, where and when permissible, and checked following the passage of a significant weather event.

All vessels under a monthly service contract with MPI will have first priority for Hurricane prep. MPI does NOT assume any responsibility or liability and is held harmless for ANY damages caused to your vessel or the property where your vessel is moored prior to, during, or after the storm. MPI is ONLY prepping the boat to the best of our ability to help minimize damage.
